6. When submitting a request for purchase, a Content Evaluation is only required if a recommending teacher is able to preview a new program or participates in an evaluation process or program.
7. Social Considerations include the following concerns: Age, Gender Roles, Aboriginal Peoples, Multiculturalism, Gender Identity and Sexual Orientation, Ability and Disability, Belief Systems, Socio-Economic, Violence, Ethical and Legal, Humor, Safety and Language.
