2.5 General Regulations

- 1. One official will be assigned by the KBOA. The league will follow FIBA rules with modified rules listed below.
- 2. Responsibilities of home (host) school: a. Provide a #6 size game ball b. Provide a scorer and timer as well as a possession arrow C. No 24 or 30 second clock will be used.
- 3. The game format will be ten shifts of four minutes stopped time. Halftime will occur at the completion of five shifts and will be five minutes running time in length.
- 4. Game substitutions will only occur at the beginning of the shifts.
- 5. A player who leaves a shift due to injury or medical reasons shall not return to the game during the same shift.
- 6. For shift changes, the horn will sound to indicate the end of the four minute shift and five new players will immediately enter the court.
- 7. Possession arrow will be utilized throughout the game and at the beginning of each new shift.
- 8. A player will continue to participate in the game until the player has five personal fouls at which time the player must leave the game.
- 9. If an offensive player is fouled in the act of shooting, the player will attempt 2 free throws
- 10. If an offensive player successfully converts a field goal and is fouled in the act of shooting, the player will attempt 1 free throw for an additional point.
- 11. If an offensive player successfully converts a three point shot and is fouled in the act of shooting, the offensive team will receive three points and the player will attempt one free throw for a possible additional point.
- 12. If a defensive team commits ten fouls in a half, the offensive team will shoot 2 free throws in bonus.
- 13. If the game is tied at the end of the tenth shift an overtime period of two minutes will occur. Five new players will enter the game for overtime. 14. If the game is tied at the end of the first or second or third overtime period, an additional shift of one minute will occur. Five new players will enter the game for each overtime period.
- 15. If a team is leading by fifteen or more points they will defend only in their backcourt. There will be no full court pressure until the difference in score is below fifteen points.
- 16. No time-outs. Games will be stop-time.
- 17. Man to man defense will be utilized by all teams.
