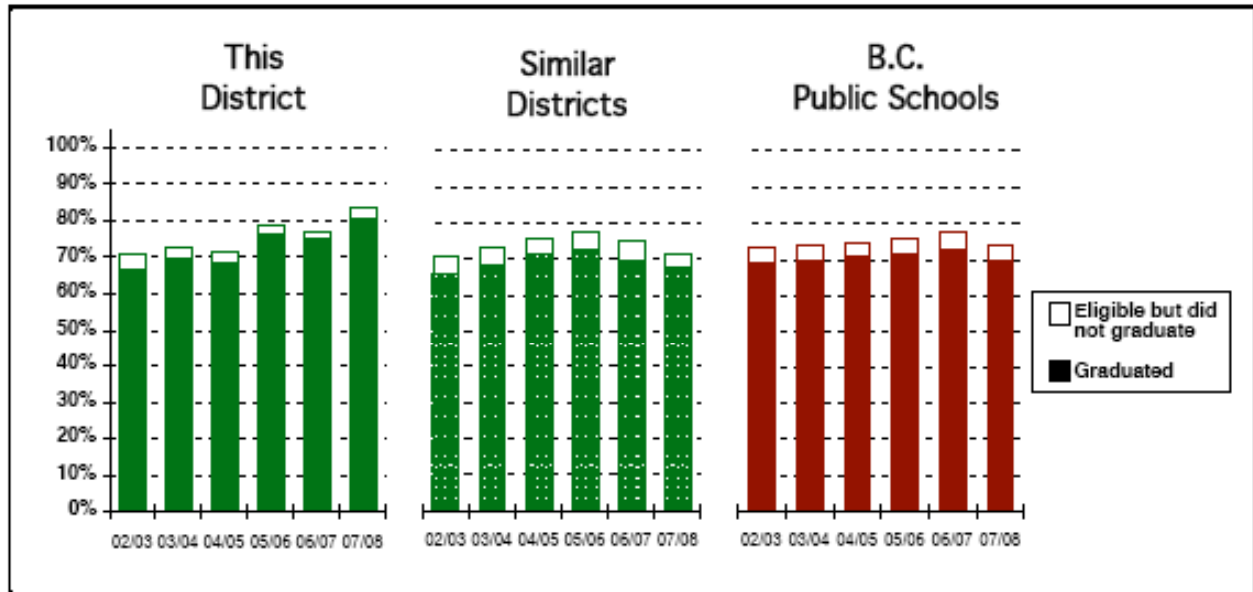

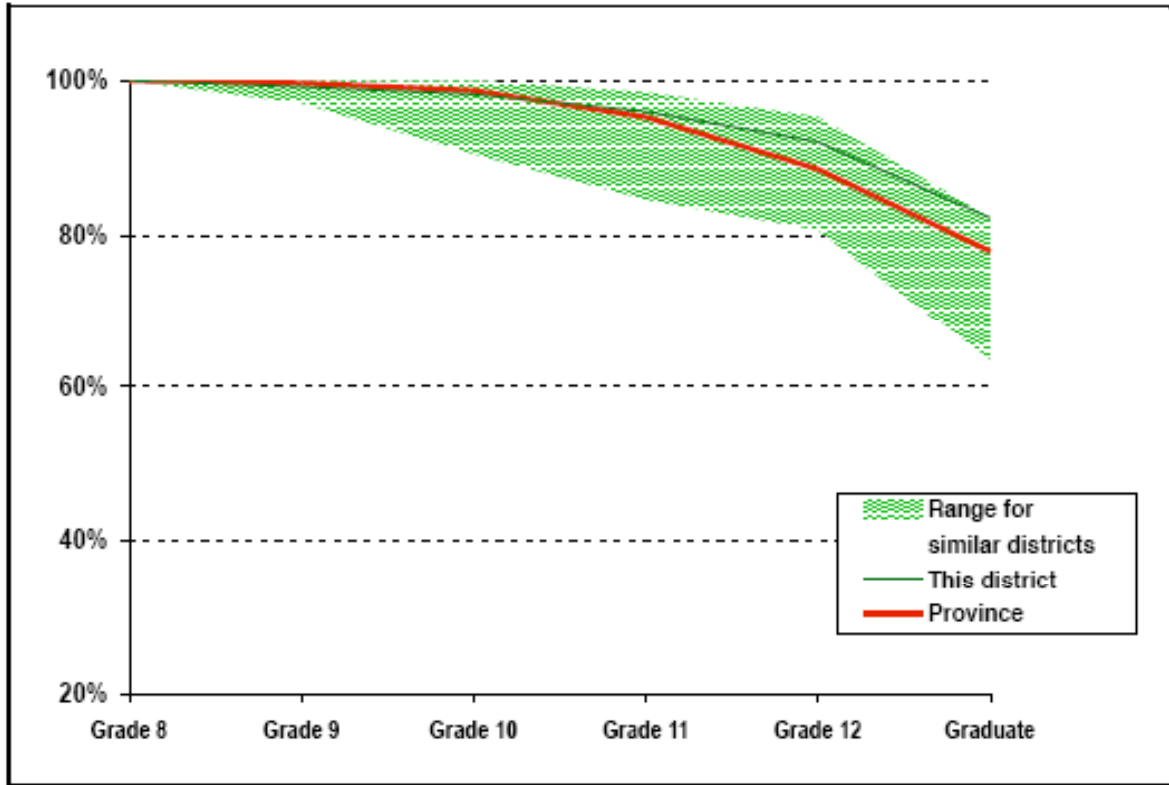

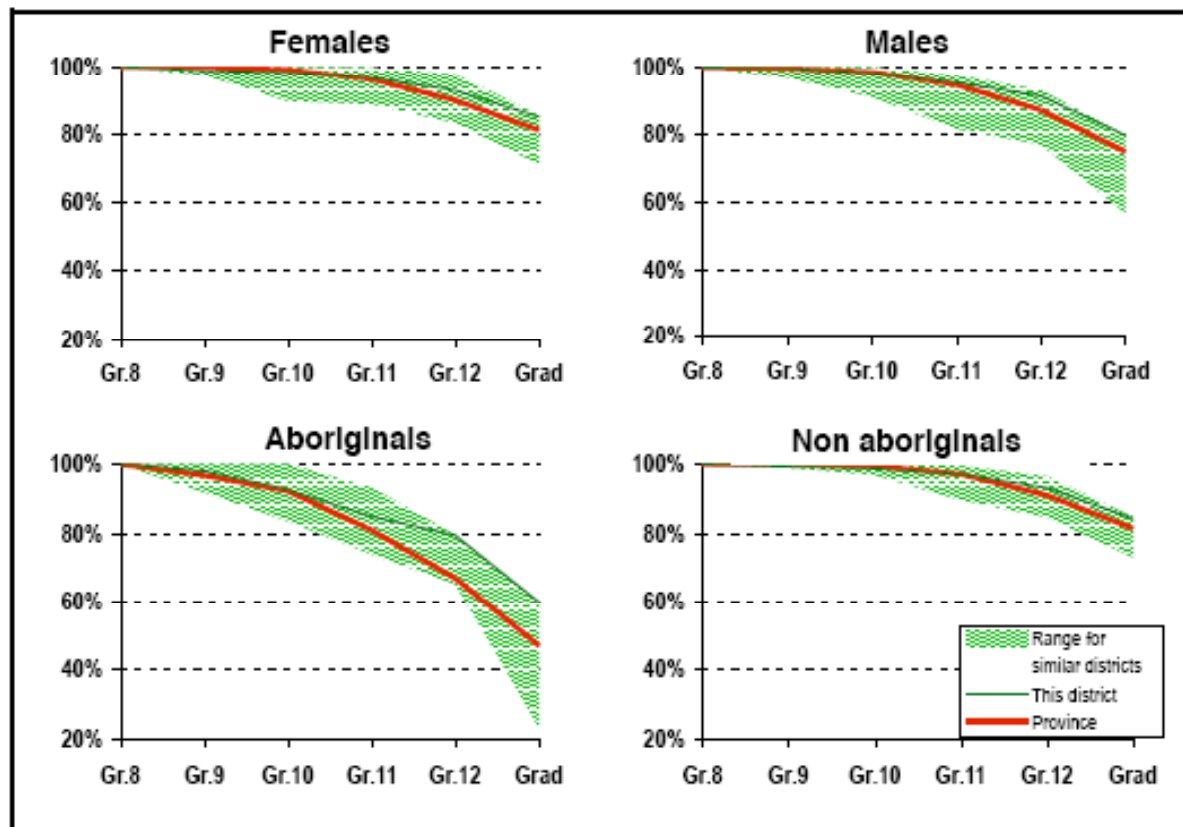
**GRADE PROGRESSION OF SINGLE COHORT OVER 6 YEARS

The number of students who moved out of the province in the six-year period is estimated from the proportion of students in grades 2 to 4 who moved out of the province during the same period. Most graduates in the sixth year are excluded, since most graduates graduate within five years. Minor changes have been made to some of the data reported prior to May 2009.

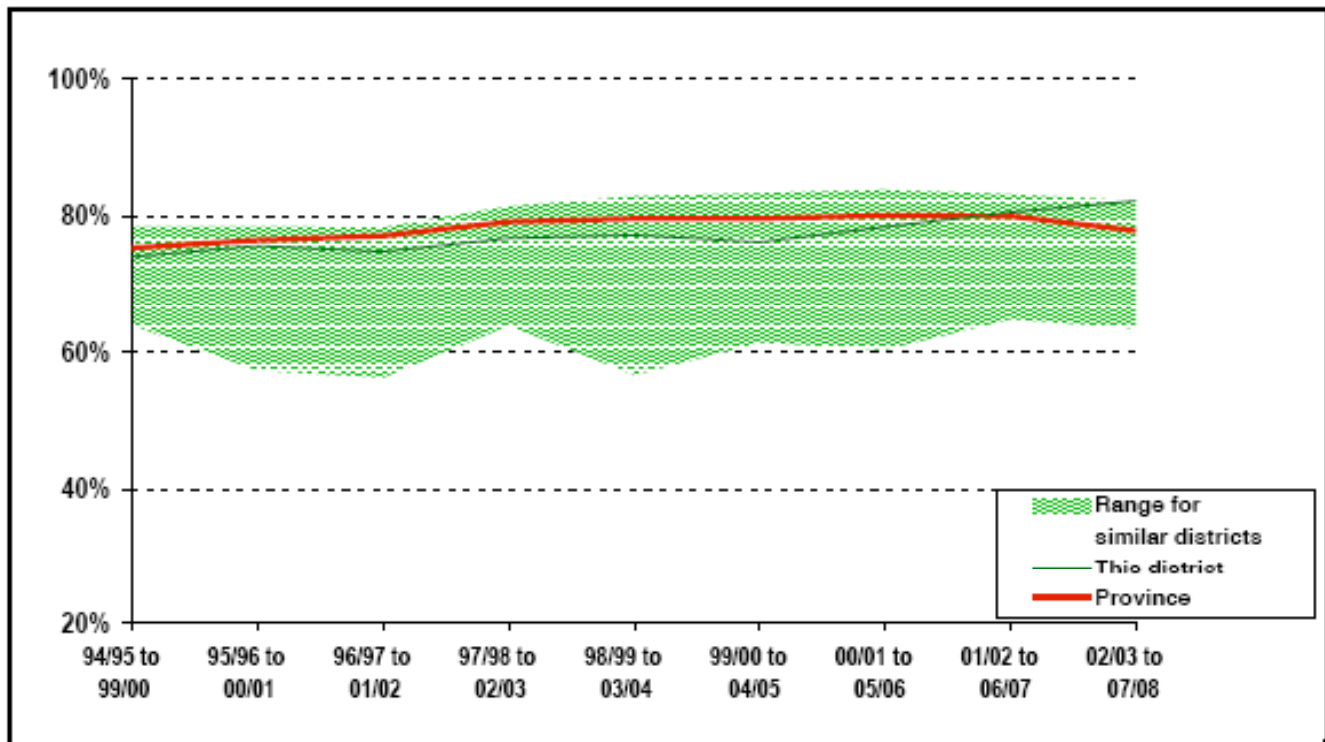

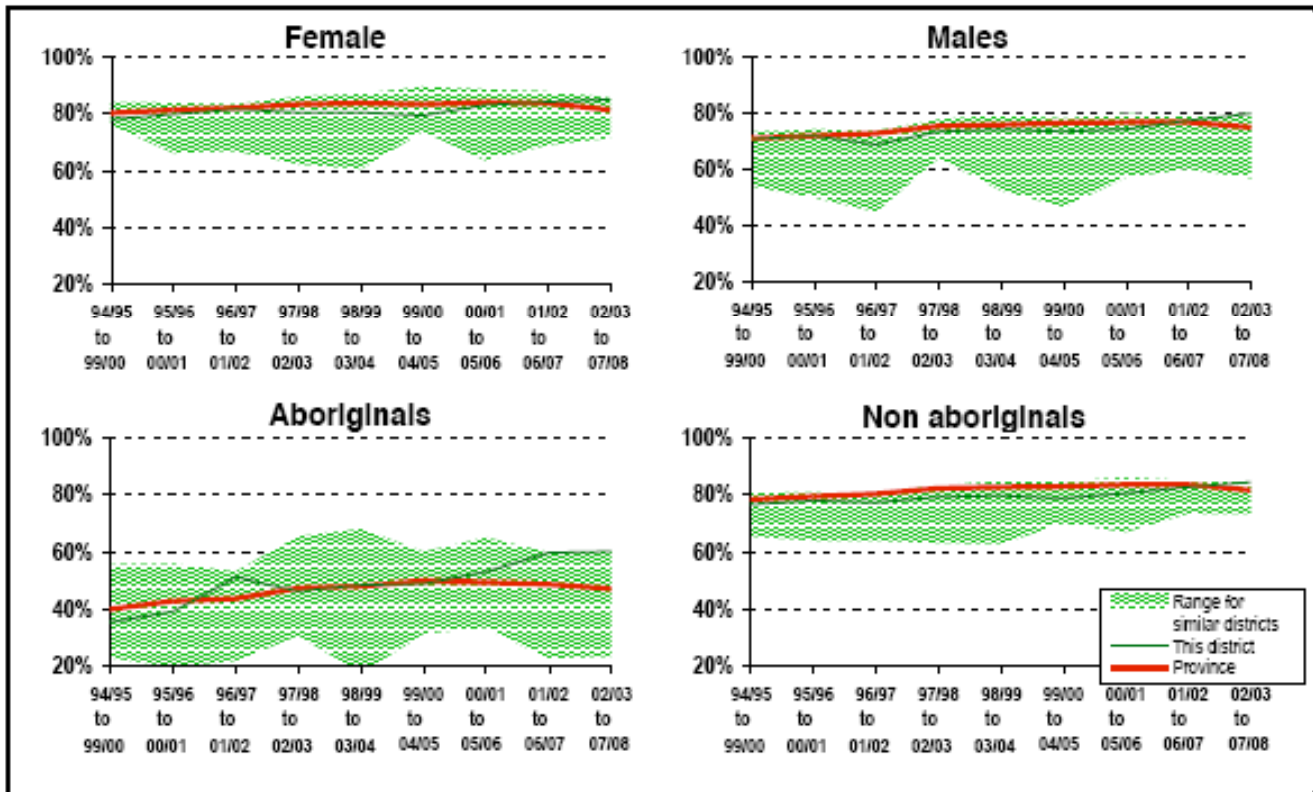

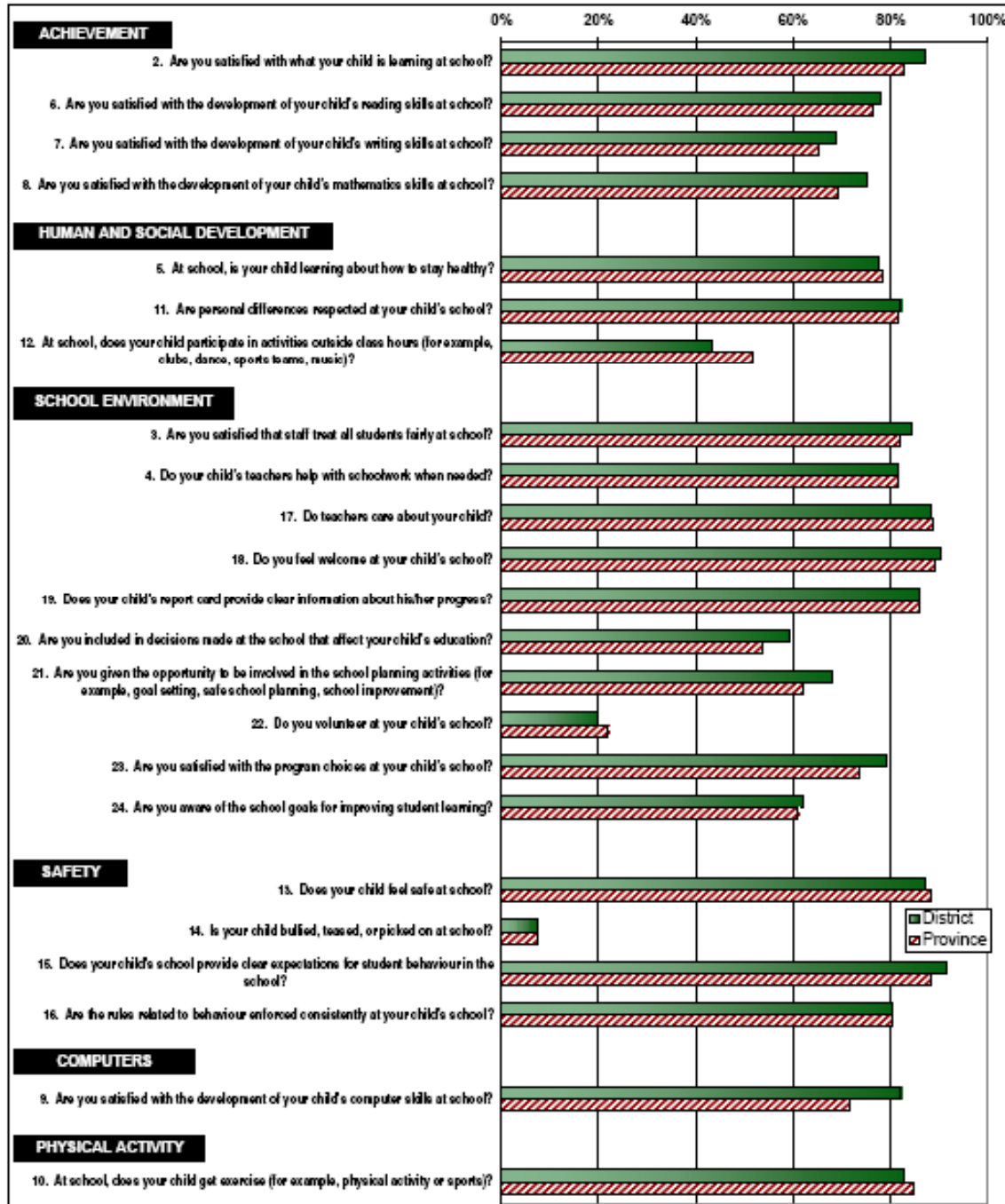

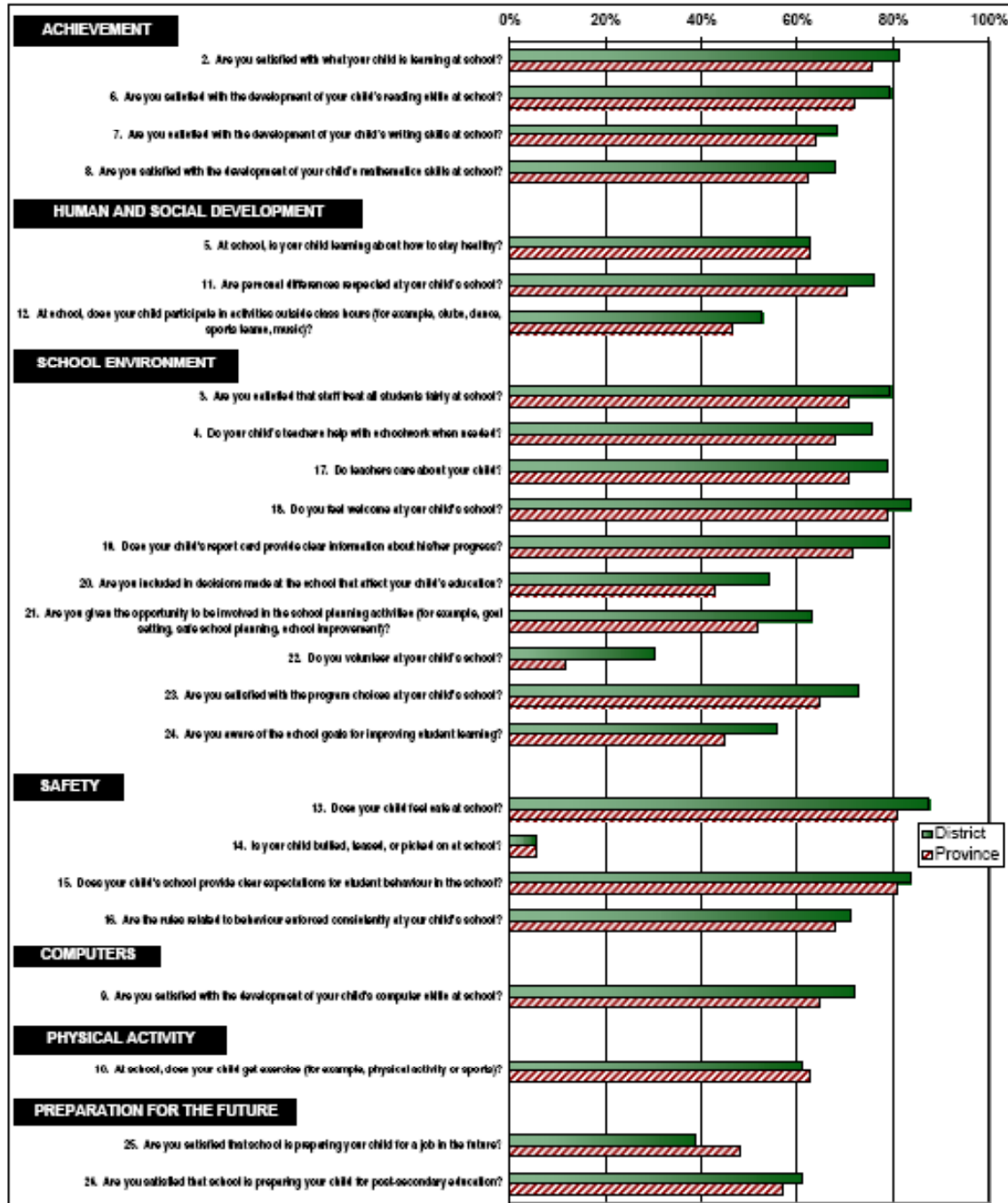
