167 – Board Participation in Collective Bargaining Process

Introduction

The purpose of this policy is to outline the role of Trustee Representatives in the Bargaining process.

Policy

1. Representation

The Board of Education shall appoint one trustee and one alternate, preferably from the Human Resources and Staff Services Committee, to the Collective Bargaining Committee to act as observers during the bargaining process. The Trustee will also provide input to the Caucus and report to the Board of Education throughout the bargaining process. A trustee who has been selected to represent the Board of Education must be eligible under the BCPSEA Constitution and Bylaws to participate in collective bargaining activities for the Association.

2. Terms of Reference

A trustee who has been selected to represent the Board of Education shall function as an observer of the Collective Bargaining Committee and participate in discussion during Caucus. The trustee will report back to the Board of Education.
