**185 – BOARD REPRESENTATION ON
COMMUNITY, MUNICIPAL AND PROVINCIAL ORGANIZATIONS**

Introduction

To fulfill its legal and community responsibilities, the Board of Education shall be represented on appropriate community organizations.

Policy

1. Representation

At the annual meeting (or a regular meeting), the Board shall elect representatives to the organizations below (for a maximum one-year term).

- BC School Trustees Association Provincial Council.
An alternate shall also be elected.
- BC Public School Employers’ Association.
An alternate shall also be elected.
- Central Okanagan Parent Advisory Council (COPAC)
- Kelowna Chamber of Commerce
- Westbank Chamber of Commerce
- Lake Country Chamber of Commerce
- Peachland Chamber of Commerce
- Regional District Parks Advisory Committee
- Community Action Towards Children's Health Committee

2. Terms of Reference

- 2.1 A trustee (or other person designated by the Board) who has been selected to represent the Board to an outside organization, may function as a full member of that organization. However, such trustees/persons must represent the stated position of the Board (subject to prior Board direction or resolution), and may not make financial or other commitments on behalf of the Board.
