**731 – COMMUNITY SERVICE AND FUNDRAISING BY SCHOOLS
(REGULATIONS)**

The approval of all external fundraising or community service activities (those involving non-school agencies or to support non-school based charities or service events) is based on the guiding principles and criteria listed in Policy 731.

Fundraising or community service is currently approved for the agencies or organizations listed below. Should a school or District group wish to raise funds or provide community service for an external agency or organization not listed, prior approval must be obtained through the Office of the Superintendent of Schools.

A written request shall be submitted to the office of the Superintendent at least two weeks in advance of any decision being required.

A copy of the listing of approved external agencies and activities shall be provided on request to any individual or group.
