## 1. Rutland Middle School Project Identification Report Update

The 2015 Rutland Middle School Project Identification Report was approved for submission to the Ministry of Education. The 2015/2016 Capital Plan submission will include a request for a school renovation for Rutland Middle School:

- Using Option 6: Repurposing Quigley Elementary School into a middle school
- With a capacity of 650 students
- With a total project budget, including reserves, of \$18,768,597.

## 2. Glenmore Secondary School Project Identification Report – Update

The Glenmore Secondary School Project Identification Report was approved for submission to the Ministry of Education. The 2015/2016 Capital Plan submission will include a request for construction funding for a new Glenmore Secondary School:

- Using Option A: Constructing a new secondary school on the Burtch Road site
- With a capacity of 1,100 students
- With a total project budget, including reserves, of \$59,016,876.
