DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS

Rewrites of Policy 436 - Managing Students with Medical Alert/Anaphylaxis Conditions and Regulations 436R - Managing Students with Medical Alert/Anaphylaxis Conditions (Regulations)

In attendance: Dr. Peter Molloy, Director of Instruction – Student Support Services

At the February 5, 2020 Policy Committee Meeting, parent Nicole Barker, parent of a student at Chute Lake Elementary, requested the members of the Committee review the Anaphylaxis-Life Threatening Allergy Handbook as prepared by the Surrey School District (No. 36) as well as Policy 304 and Administrative Procedures 304 of the Vancouver School District (No. 39). The rewrites of Policy 436 – Managing Students with Medical Alert/Anaphylaxis Conditions and Regulations 436R – Managing Students with Medical Alert/Anaphylaxis Conditions have been prepared by Dr. Peter Molloy, Director of Instruction – Student Support Services and Cori Christensen, District Consultant – Elementary and Middle School Low Incidence after review of the documentation noted above, as well as consultation with Interior Health and the Ministry of Education.

The Committee discussed an amendment to the documentation that a second injection could be administered 5-15 minutes after if symptoms do not improve.

Outcome:

THAT: The Policy Committee recommends to the Board:

THAT: The rewrites of Policy 436 - Managing Students with Medical Alert/Anaphylaxis Conditions and Regulations 436R - Managing Students with Medical Alert/Anaphylaxis Conditions (Regulations), as further amended at the May 6, 2020 Policy Committee Meeting, be forwarded to the Board of Education for approval.

AND THAT: Once the rewrites of Policy 436 - Managing Students with Medical Alert/Anaphylaxis Conditions and Regulations 436R - Managing Students with Medical Alert/Anaphylaxis Conditions (Regulations), are approved by the Board of

Education, the Superintendent of Schools/CEO work with staff on any further amendments required.

<u>Review of Policy 351 - Respectful Workplace and Amendments to Regulations 351R - Respectful Workplace (Regulations)</u>

Referred from the Policy Working Committee – March 9, 2020

At the October 23, 2019 Public Board Meeting the Board of Education approved the amendments referred from the October 2, 2019 Policy Committee Meeting, with the exception of the amendment to item 3.5 in Regulation 351R. A Policy Committee Working Group met on November 26, 2019 and on March 9, 2020 to further review Policy 351 and Regulations 351R.

The recommended amendments from the Policy Committee Working Group are being brought forward for the Committee's review.

Upon the recommendation of Trustee Geistlinger, the language of item 1.1 in Policy 351 – Respectful Workplace is to be reviewed. The Superintendent of Schools/CEO will review the paragraph and bring back to the Policy Committee suggested amendments for clarity. Punctuation amendments were suggested.

Further discussions occurred on the addition of "*This process is voluntary*" at the end of paragraph 1, and the wording in Step 2, Item 1 to include ".....a formal written complaint would be made, directed to the Supervisor who has responsibility......".

Outcome:

A meeting will be scheduled as between the Superintendent of Schools/CEO, Executive Director of Human Resources, District Health & Safety Manager and the COTA representative to review the wording of Item 1 under Step 3. The amendments to the Policy will subsequently be brought back to a future Policy Committee Meeting.

Amendments to Policy 135 - School Board Operation

The suggested amendments were referred to the Policy Committee from the February 12, 2020 Public Board Meeting. Two further amendments were recommended by the Committee - item 4.5 the change of email to electronic communication and the addition of Public to the title of item 7.

Outcome:

THAT: The Policy Committee recommends to the Board:

THAT: The amendments to Policy 135 - School Board Operation, as further amended at the May 6, 2020 Policy Committee Meeting, be forwarded to the Board of Education for approval.

Amendments to Policy 190 - Trustee Expenses

The Secretary-Treasurer/CFO confirmed that the addition of Item 2.7 is a housekeeping item. Additional amendments are to be made to make the Policy gender neutral.

<u>Amendments to Policy 405 - Student Placement and Regulations 405R - Student Placement (Regulations)</u>

The amendments to Policy 405 – Student Placement and Regulations 405R – Student Placement (Regulations), were deferred from the February 5, 2020 Policy Committee Meeting for further discussion. The amendments are the addition of reference to French Immersion Programs catchment areas. Additional amendments include the removal of "as set by the Board" in item 4 of the Policy and replacing with "The capping of schools is set by the Board" at the end of the paragraph. The Committee discussed the inclusion of teachers in paragraph 3.2 of the Regulations. The Superintendent of Schools/CEO suggested the changing of the wording to "....in consultation with those affected in the school community and the Director of Operations or designate if necessary". The Superintendent of Schools/CEO will further review the Regulations and the amendments to the Policy and Regulations will be deferred to the next Policy Committee Meeting.

THAT: The amendments to Policy 405 - Student Placement and Regulations 405R - Student Placement (Regulations), along with the amendments suggested at the May 6, 2020 Policy Committee Meeting, be deferred to the next Policy Committee Meeting.
