



MDI data collection was completed in early March. All grade 5 students in the district took part. Results should be reported in June.

McCreary data collection is ongoing, it started in January and runs through May. 59 classes from Grade 7 to 12 participating. Results coming next school year.

Consent Lesson

This initiative stemmed from a group of youth activists who have highlighted the importance of comprehensive consent education in K to grade 12 classrooms.
