2. PRESIDENT'S REPORT Michelle Crossley

3. TREASURER'S REPORT Michelle Scheibel

Discussion

Bank Accounts Reconciled to April 19th
Gaming account balance \$8,956.01
PAC Account balance \$52,206.90 (less \$13,733.73 for playground accessibility) \$38,473.17

Updates:

- 1) Here is a summary of fundraising so far this year, not including hot lunch since there are still expenses to be paid for the remainder of the year
 - So far we have fundraised \$13,707 (this includes the gaming grant \$4560)
 - Revenue still to come Dance??
 - Spirit Wear \$168.74 (this is after all the item PAC purchased to sell another time or giveaway)
 - Greenery \$600
 - Expenses so far are \$4,058

Net Revenue \$10,417.74

Our budget goal was to Fundraise \$12,500 not including the gaming grant or hot lunch revenue (we wanted \$4000). It will be interesting to see where we end up after the dance. Hot lunch profit will be close to \$4000 maybe less since we are going more subsidies.

- 2) From our net bank balance \$38,473.17 plus gaming account \$8,956.01 I estimate the following upcoming expenses:
 - Hot lunch expenses \$15,500
 - Sandbox updates and painted lines and basketball hoops \$3000
 - Inflatables day? \$2100
 - Est net balance \$17,873.17 plus gaming account \$8,956.01

Our budget outlines we wanted to keep a reserve of \$10,000 for contingency, so we are within out budget

- 3) Capital Improvement Playgroud
 - We were unsuccessful with the grant writing for the playground, but they have agreed to credit us back the money or put it towards the accessible bus that was quoted on earlier this year (quote included)
 - SD23 cash online also have money for the playground \$10,739.09 plus the PAC account for \$13,733.73
 - Quote came in at \$29,067.93 (after the credit applied)
 - Vote to use PAC funds to cover shortfall to complete this project before prices keep rising \$4,595.11

Capital Improvement School Sound System (Nadia was looking into) I think we still have enough left over after the playground to put effort into that initiative too
