SPRING FIELDS

At this time of year, we sometimes get complaints of rotten-egg odors on the school fields. The health authority assures us that this is not a sewer or septic tank problem, but rather an "anaerobic" bacteria growing in the muddy soil where all nutrients are, such as fertilizer. The smell can become particularly bad after heavy snowfall during fluctuating spring temperatures, when the ground goes through cycles of thawing and refreezing. We hope the fields stay odor-free!

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED TRACK AND FIELD FOR INTERMEDIATE STUDENTS



The intermediate students from South Kelowna Elementary School will be participating in Track and Field events 2 days per week at school **starting April 21st**.

In order to run 7 stations on each of these days, we will need parent volunteers to run a station along with the 3 intermediate teachers.

(Stations needing volunteers are: High Jump, Triple Jump & the two running events - 800m & 100m/relay).

The days we will need commitment from our volunteers are **Wednesday** and **Friday afternoons**. On each of these days, we will need our volunteers at the school for 12:00 pm. We will be starting the 20 minute station rotations at **12:15 ending at 1:20 pm**.

SCHOOL SECURITY


Safety is our number one concern here at South Kelowna Elementary. As such, we would like to remind our parents of a number of security precautions in place:

- All outside doors remain locked during the day, except the front entrance door, which is visible to the office. Anyone who enters the school is expected to report to the office and notify the secretary or principal of their purpose.
- > Volunteers are welcome to support students. Please make prior arrangements with classroom teachers and remember to sign-in in the booklet in the forum at the front entrance.
- Instructional time is important for learning, therefore, we ask visitors to refrain from loitering in school hallways.
- All visitors are asked to report to the office, sign in and out, and wear a visitor's badge while in the school.
- Morning playground supervision is from 8:10 8:30 am and after school from 2:30 2:45 pm. There is no supervision after 2:45 pm. Students must report home after 2:45 pm or have a parent with them to play after 2:45 pm.
- > Please pre-arrange playdates in advance. Our school phone is meant for calling home, not to set-up after school playdates.
- Students waiting for parent pick-up during the day are asked to wait inside the school.
- > Safety procedures (fire drill, earthquake drill, lock-down drill) are practiced regularly.
- Parents are asked NOT to use our student washrooms please ask at the office to use our staff adult washrooms.

SAFETY REMINDERS

Home Safety - Walking Home

- · Do a visual check as you are walking. Look out for strange people and strange vehicles.
- · When possible, walk with others.



- · Don't take anything from a stranger and do not approach the stranger's vehicle.
- · Be polite but be firm. If the stranger continues to bother you, go to a neighbour's home. If neighbours are too far away, discuss with your parents an alternate plan. Develop a password to use when your parents send someone to pick you up.

Bikes, Skateboards, Scooters, Rollerblades

Please note that bicycles, scooters, skateboards and rollerblades **may not** be used on school property. Bicycles and scooters must be walked on school property and stored for the day. *Helmets are mandatory*. Please use a lock to secure bikes to the bike rack upon arrival at school. Scooters must be folded and stored in the classroom. Skateboards are to be carried on school property and stored away for the day.

Bike Safety

Bikes are ridden with the flow of traffic. Helmets and arm signals must be used for safety. Bikes are walked in the crosswalk and on school property. Bike racks are out of bounds during school hours.

Bus Safety

Skateboards are not anowed on the school bus. Skateboards become potential projectiles if the bus driver ever has to perform an evasive maneuver. Small items may be carried onto the bus (including a musical instrument) if they will fit under the seat or on your lap. If the driver thinks an item will block the aisle, floor space, or seat, it will not be allowed on the bus.





ONLINE APPLICATION for STUDENT ENROLLMENT begins on Monday, January 30, 2023, at 7:00 am for 2023 - 2024 School Year

(for kindergarten, new students, and Programs of Choice for K - 12)

Schools will be open at 7:00 am to provide telephone support to parents that require assistance.

HOW TO APPLY

PLEASE NOTE: The application process is online only. You are required to have a valid email account.

In your web browser type: https://enrollment.sd23.bc.ca

No internet access? Please contact your school for assistance.

Online applications begin on Monday, January 30, 2023 at 7:00 am. Applications will be assigned a date-time stamp on a first-come, first-served basis, which will factor into a student's placement priority.

Complete the online application as early as possible, and provide the required documents listed below <u>directly to the school</u> by email by **Friday, March 17, 2023**.

- 1. Student's **Birth Certificate** or other government issued proof of age and citizenship.
- 2. Proof of Parent/Guardian B.C. Residency
 - a. Combination BC Driver's License and Services Card (copy of both sides); or,
 - b. BC Services Card (copy of both sides) and one item from the list of supporting documentation below; or,
 - c. Proof of application for BC Medical Services Plan and one item from the list of supporting documentation below.
- 3. Proof of Parent/Guardian Living Address/Supporting Documentation
 - Ownership of a dwelling or long-term lease or rental of a dwelling;
 - Documentation indicating British Columbia residence (i.e. utility bill);
 - British Columbia registration of an automobile;
 - British Columbia Driver's License (copy of both sides); or,
 - A current income tax return filed as a British Columbia resident.

AFTER Thursday, August 31, 2023

New in-catchment area enrollments: Parents will receive a confirmation email when the school has accepted the student's application for enrollment. Board Policy 405R – Student Placement (Regulations), will be used to determine student placement and priority.

New out-of-catchment area enrollments: Parents <u>may not</u> be notified until after the summer enrollment period is over and all in-catchment area students have been placed.

Qualifying age: The School Act requires that a child must be five years of age by December 31, 2023, to qualify for school enrollment in September 2023. No exceptions.
