Bank accounts reconciled April 19th

- Gaming Account Balance \$13,411.11 (Includes \$9000 for playground) NET \$4411.11
- PAC #545 Account Balance \$43,365.75 (includes \$13,735.73 for Playground) NET \$29,630.02

Quick Numbers on where we are at so far:

- July 1<sup>st</sup> 2021 Cash in Accounts totaled \$27,656.16
- Profit from July 1 2021 April 19, 2022 \$28,967.77
- Less: Play Ground Money not yet paid out \$22,735.73
- Net profit added to last years balance \$6232.04

Essentially, we have been able to spend most of the budget laid out for this school year, plus donate an extra \$9000 towards the playground, and still add to last years bank balance for \$6232.04. There are still two months left to go in the school year with the revenue for Purdy's and Greenery Fundraiser not yet received. VERY WELL DONE!!!
