KELOWNA, BC – With students back in school across the district, school zones are back in effect. Central Okanagan Public Schools reminds the community to slow down, watch for crosswalks, and stop behind buses.

"This year we have an increased focus on safety for students and staff," said Moyra Baxter, Chairperson of the Board of Education. "We need the public to help keep everyone safe on their way to and from school as well, so leave yourself some extra time to get where you're going and be cautious."

School zone speed limits of 30km/h are in effect on school days from 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. everywhere in the Central Okanagan.
