Submitting game situations would be greatly appreciated. The following plays will be based on situations with High School Modifications where applicable.

Play #1: On the opening jump ball, A1 taps the ball directly out of bounds in (a) Team B's front court; (b) Team B's backcourt.

In (a); Team B shall be awarded a throw-in with 18 seconds on the shot clock; in (b); Team B shall be awarded a throw-in with 30 seconds on the shot clock. Team A shall be entitled to next AP Arrow throw-in with the AP arrow pointing toward their opponents basket. Rule: 12.6.2; 12.6.4; 29.2.7. Interpretations: 12-6.

Play #2: After A2 has completed his dribble in A's frontcourt. A2 attempt a cross-court pass from just outside the 3-point line to A3. The passed ball strikes the ring, bounces up and then enters the basket.

Team A (&A2) shall be awarded 3 points. Rule: 16.2.1. Interpretations: 16-1.

Play #3: A5 commits a traveling violation while attempting to score a field goal. The ball enters the basket.

The basket shall be disallowed - Team B shall be awarded a throw-in at the free throw line extended. The shot clock shall be set to 30 seconds. Rule: 17.2.9. Interpretations: 17-51.

Play #4: A4 ends a dribble with the ball in the hands. In continuous motion, A4 jumps off the left foot, lands on the left foot, then on the right foot and attempts a try for goal.

A traveling violation has occurred. After ending a dribble, a player may not contact the floor consecutively with the same foot. Rule: 25.1.1; 25.2.1. Interpretations: 25-5.
