2. Natalie Bickert, Parent - Presentation

Ms. Bickert provided a presentation outlining, from a parent's perspective, suggestions for budget allocation, which included smaller classes, a nurse in each school, more Teachers' Aids and textbooks, Homework Clubs in each school, at least one more middle school and one more high school, more time spent on each class unit for better understanding, more safety awareness for administration, educators and students with regards to concussions, mandatory protective gear for physical education classes and a resolution to the current Teacher Job Action.

The Superintendent responded that many of the budget allocation suggestions would have significant dollar amounts attached to them.

Ms. Bickert was thanked for her presentation.

Public Question/Comment Period

The COTA President requested information regarding the recent speech from the throne which contained an announcement from the Provincial Government regarding an addition of \$165 million dollars province-wide towards more Teaching Assistants.

The Board Chairperson and the Superintendent advised that the school district has not received official notification regarding the increased funding for additional Teaching Assistants. The Superintendent advised that, should the funding be distributed as stated, School District No. 23 would receive an estimated 4% of the amount. The District will await further details from the province.

Discussion/Action Items

1. Policy 207 "Investments" and the Investment Portfolio Review Report

The Director of Finance reviewed information contained within Board Policy 207 "Investments" and noted that the District's professional investment advisor is RBC Dominion Securities. The District's portfolio is invested conservatively, and is performing well above market expectations with a reasonable return. The Committee discussed the contents of the Investment Portfolio Review Report.

Outcome

The Finance and Legal Committee received the Investment Portfolio Review Report.

2. Amended Annual Budget Fiscal Year 2011/2012

The Director of Finance provided a brief review of the budget process which begins with a preliminary budget being drafted in the spring. Once actual enrolments and staffing have been confirmed for the next school year, an amended annual budget is presented to the Board of Education. The committee reviewed the amended annual budget information.

Outcome

The Committee recommended that the Amended Annual Budget Fiscal Year 2011/2012, as attached and as presented at the February 15, 2012 Finance and Legal Committee, be sent to the Board of Education for approval.

3. Revenue and Expense Summary at January 31, 2012

The Director of Finance outlined the financial statement review process which provides Revenue and Expense Summaries to the Committee every three months. The summary contains information on revenue and expenditure statements as of January 31, 2012, a comparative to last year, as well as amended annual budget 2011/2012 information. The Labour Market Adjustment Grant for Trades has been discontinued; however Trades adjustment funding remains in place. The Director of Finance responded to Committee member queries regarding the summary.

Outcome

The Committee received the Revenue and Expense Summary at January 31, 2012, and recommended that the Summary be forwarded to the Board of Education as an information item.
