Capital Improvement Update:

- 1) We have gone forwards with the work orders through SD23 to update the basketball hoops and painted lines on the court as well as redo the sandboxes and fill with sand. Work to be completed in the spring.
- 2) I have been working directly with a supplier called Green Roots for the Playground accessibility piece. Karol, who is SD23 physical therapist and myself are working together to ensure the piece will meet the needs of someone in a wheelchair with the hope there will be no transfer required from the wheel chair to the play equipment.

Option 1) We finally found a piece we both liked with is a bus that would be placed on top of rubber surfacing we would complete and add on to

Option 2) Green Roots now has full time staff member dedicated to writing grant proposals. Cost is \$2500 and if they are successful they credit \$2000 off the final invoice for the equipment we purchase.

Quote Estimate: Cost of Piece \$17,356 Rubber Surface \$13,000 Est Install \$6,000 Shipping \$4,300 GST \$2,032 Est Total \$43,021

PAC Currently has \$24,472
