### 2. BACKGROUND

At the first Public Board Meeting of the year held on September 12, 2018, general information was provided for the time period of July 1 through September 7, 2018. As there have been additional adjustments and refinements since September 7, 2018, it was agreed that Part 2 of the School Opening Report would be provided to the Board on September 26, 2018.

#### 3. INFORMATION STATEMENT

#### **District Enrolment Trends**

Overall, District enrolment has increased by **339** students over last year. As of September 21, 2018 there are **22,753** students registered in Central Okanagan Public Schools. The differences between this year and last year are as follows:

- Secondary schools are 43 students over their projected enrolment, and they have 312 more students than they had by September 30, 2017.
- Middle schools are 15 students under their projected enrolment, and they have 293 more students than they had by September 30, 2017.
- Elementary schools are 6 students less than their projected enrolment, and 275 less students than they had in September of 2017.
- Alternate student enrolment is currently **414** students compared to **405** students for the same time last year. However, this number is expected to increase prior to the provincial enrolment count of September 30, 2018.

Appendix A provides a detailed analysis of the change in enrolment by individual school, level and zone between last year and this year.
