ADVOCACY

Update: BCSTA Motions Passed at AGM

The Board Chair provided an update on the BCSTA Motions passed at the recent BCSTA Annual General Meeting held on April 24 - 26, 2025, in Vancouver, BC. A Motion on Adequate Funding for Costs in Childcare and a Motion on Teaching Critical Thinking in K-12 were brought forth and both were passed unanimously.

The Board Chair also advised she had met with the Honorable Bowinn Ma, Minister of Infrastructure, regarding capital projects being built faster as the province aims to speed up permitting due to the new legislation.

BOARD/DISTRICT COMMITTEE QUERIES/COMMENTS AND REPORTS

Trustee Tiede attended the District Early Years Partnership Committee meeting on May 6, 2025 where they discussed the new standalone childcare facility opening on July 1, 2025 at École Hudson Road Elementary school and operated by BGC Okanagan. Trustee Tiede also acknowledged that May 9, 2025 was National Childcare Provider Appreciation Day, and shared a video highlighting outdoor learning spaces.

Trustee Johnson attended the May 12, 2025 District Student Council (DSC) meeting where they discussed self-care during a busy time in life, upcoming DSC elections, the Mental Health Week

activities at all the schools, as well as the Walk for Mental Health at Mount Boucherie Secondary School.

District Student Council rep Anna Kristin elaborated on the Walk for Mental Health at Mount Boucherie Secondary and offered heartfelt kudos to fellow DSC rep Delaney Neukomm for her incredible efforts on creating and coordinating the Walk over the past few years.

Trustee Guderyan attended the April 14, 2025 District Student Council meeting where they discussed creating a video series on cyber bullying. Trustee Guderyan also attended the Heath Promoting Schools Committee meeting where they had a presentation from the Information Technology Team on digital literacy. She also attended the District Safe Schools Community Network Meeting earlier in the day, where they discussed data from September, 2025 to present is showing a noticeable rise in youth vulnerability and ways the District is responding. The City of Kelowna also has a new position to help with the challenges of youth gangs and exploitation. Trustee Guderyan also requested information on the HRVY Colour Run event to share with Trustees.

Trustee Geistlinger mentioned that Rhonda Ovelson, Director of Instruction – Feeding Futures gave a presentation at the May 7, 2025 Education and Student Services Committee on food literacy – which encompasses knowledge, attitude and skills about food, and also highlighted all the food programs support that the District provides to students.

Trustee Desrosiers attended the COPAC meeting on May 5, 2025 ahead of their AGM and thanked the COPAC members for their dedication.

- Attendance at various meetings and events throughout the District, including School Community Learning Plan Conversations at Canyon Falls Middle, Helen Gorman Elementary, École Okanagan Mission Secondary and École Kelowna Secondary. Other events included retirement celebrations, assemblies, concerts and Track and Field Meets.
- Trustees, the Superintendent of Schools/CEO and senior staff participated in the new George Pringle Secondary final beam signing ceremony. This event marked a significant milestone in the installation of the final beam in the steel structure.

- Congratulations to the volunteers, students and staff on the organization of another very successful Mount Boucherie Secondary School Walk for Mental Health held on May 8, 2025. Over 2,200 people gathered at Mount Boucherie Secondary School to raise awareness and money for Foundry Kelowna, a mental health resource operated by the Canadian Mental Health Association for youth aged 12-24.
