COVID-19 EXPOSURES ANNOUNCED IN CENTRAL OKANAGAN SCHOOLS

November 11, 2020

KELOWNA, BC – Interior Health confirmed the following exposures at Central Okanagan Public Schools today, in addition to those announced earlier in the day:

- Single exposure at Okanagan Mission Secondary School
- Single exposure at École KLO Middle School
- Single exposure at École Casorso Elementary School

The exposures do not appear to be related to transmission within their respective schools. All individuals are self-isolating at home with support from local public health teams. Interior Health follows up with anyone potentially exposed to a confirmed case directly through contact tracing.

The safety and well-being of students, families, and staff remains our highest priority. Central Okanagan Public Schools will continue to implement the strict health and safety protocols and procedures that are in place so students and staff can continue to attend school as safely as possible.

Central Okanagan Public Schools will continue to work closely with Interior Health to determine if any additional actions are required, and to support ongoing communication to each affected school community. As always, we remind people to stay home from school if they show any symptoms.
