Presentation: RBC Learn to Play Leadership Grant - \$25,000

Presenters: Janelle Zebedee and Tricia Labrie, Health Promoting Schools Coordinators, and Stephanie French, Teacher at Casorso Elementary School. Ms. Zebedee and Ms. Labrie acknowledged the current grant and the Board was provided with information and a presentation regarding the RBC Learn to Play Leadership Project which provides grants to local organizations and communities in support of building the physical literacy of Canada's youth.
