Updates on School Opening for January 6, 2015

Kelowna, B.C.

Thank you to our parents and community for your support and understanding in responding to this morning's school closures due to the inclement weather.

We are continuing to monitor both the Environment Canada weather forecast as well as feedback regarding the success of snow clearing efforts in order to make a decision regarding school opening tomorrow, Tuesday, January 6th. (Even if our schools are in a position to open tomorrow, we have been advised that many of our bus routes will not be cleared in time to enable buses to perform their normal runs.)

We will endeavor to send out a News Release to all our media contacts, and post to our website and the individual school websites **by no later than 7:00 am tomorrow morning** as to the status of school operations in the Central Okanagan School District. The current forecast is for snow to continue tonight and this may be followed by freezing rain. If it snows heavily throughout the evening, we may make a decision about the status of our schools tonight.
