# 2. Amended Annual Budget Fiscal Year – 2015/2016

The Board of Education gave first, second and third readings, passed and adopted, the School District No. 23 (Central Okanagan) Amended Annual Budget Bylaw for 2015/2016 in the amount of \$227,720,438.

## The following items were reviewed by the Board:

#### 1. Ministry Recalculation Allocation – School District No. 23 and Provincial

The Central Okanagan School District on average received \$8,855 per pupil.

## 2. January 1, 2016 Compensation Increase for Principals and Vice-Principals

On January 13, 2016 the Board of Education approved a second compensation increase (maximum 2%) for most Principals and Vice-Principals, to be implemented once approved by the Public Sector Employers' Council (PSEC). PSEC approved the increase in the latter part of January 2016. The previous increase (2%), retroactive to July 1, 2015, was approved by the Board of Education on December 14, 2015.

- 2. Congratulations was extended to the organizers, supporters and fans of the very successful Interior Savings Western Canada Basketball Tournament held this past weekend at KSS.
