Funding Review Report

Presenter: Kevin Kaardal, Superintendent of Schools/CEO

In February 2018, the Minister of Education appointed a seven member Independent Funding Model Review Panel to review and provide recommendations to the way funding is allocated in the K-12 public education sector in British Columbia. The review and recommendations were informed by feedback received during one-on-one meetings with sector partners and stakeholders, regional meetings with or survey submissions from all 60 school district leadership teams, and over 100 written submissions from a range of other stakeholder and partner organizations. Perspectives were also received from First Nations, partner groups, K-12 public education stakeholder organizations, as well as community organizations, individual parents and parent groups.

The presentation by the Superintendent of Schools/CEO outlined the 22 recommendations from the Independent Funding Model Review Panel. Further in-depth discussions on the

recommendations will take place at future Finance and Audit Committee and Education and Student Services Committee Meetings. The Committees will then bring back to the Board their recommendations.

Dear Ms. Baxter:

Thank you for your letter of November 27, 2018, regarding the replacement of Rutland Middle School within the Central Okanagan School District.

The province is experiencing rapid enrolment growth in many districts, including Central Okanagan, and the Ministry of Education is working hard to keep up with this growth. Additionally, there are many schools to upgrade in the Seismic Mitigation Program, and the safety of students and teachers is a top priority. For these reasons government has prioritized new schools and additions projects to reduce the reliance on portables, and the acceleration of the Seismic Mitigation Program to make schools seismically safe as soon as possible.

Since 2007, there have been 2,940 added or approved new student spaces in Central Okanagan School District, with funding of \$131.26 million announced for these six projects. Please see the table below for the specific capacity added per school.

I know the replacement of Rutland Middle School has been a priority for the Central Okanagan Board of Education for several years now. Every year school districts submit many requests from across the province for renovations and replacement schools, but the Ministry is required to prioritize these requests against approved capital budgets. At this time, a capital project at Rutland Middle School is not approved for funding.

I am aware of the expansion priorities in your District's 2019/20 capital plan submission, such as a new site and secondary school in West Kelowna. These expansion requests are also being considered as part of the government's capital planning process for Budget 2019.
