Presentation: Balanced School Calendar Report

The Superintendent provided a review of the Balanced School Calendar Report which was commissioned by several metro school districts in order to provide current research information on the balanced school year concept. The definition of a balanced school year is a school calendar that distributes holiday periods more evenly throughout the calendar year. School calendars must comply with any relevant requirements within a Board's collective agreements. Beginning in 2013/2014, the provincial government has instituted new calendar legislation and has moved to hours of instruction rather than days in session.

The research did not consider the implications of running a balanced calendar in a multi-track format, four-day weeks or other calendar changes that decrease the number of school days and lengthen the remaining days to compensate. Nor did it look at variations in the length or scheduling of a school day, or capital and operating costs associated with a balanced school calendar.

There is no reliable research base upon which to form any conclusions about the effect of a balanced calendar on staff or student health. Boards wishing to consider a balanced school calendar should explore the compelling reason for the change, what support would be required to achieve the change, what research/experience is available for review, and what logistical challenges/secondary impacts could be foreseen in schools and communities.

The Board agreed that the Balanced School Calendar Report would be forwarded to the District's Calendar Committee for their information.

Additional improvements cannot be made without approval from the District of West Kelowna for a second access onto Daimler Road. Additional curbing and sidewalks on Daimler Road are also required and these upgrades fall under the jurisdiction of the District of West Kelowna. The Secretary-Treasurer will contact the District of West Kelowna regarding the status of future improvements to the site.
