Trustee Baxter queried if the portable information provided at the Central Okanagan Parent Advisory Council would be provided to the Board of Education.

The Secretary-Treasurer/CFO confirmed that the portable information will be provided at the next Planning and Facilities Committee Meeting.

Discussion/Action Items

1. Trustee Indemnity for the 2018/2019 Fiscal Year

The Assistant Secretary-Treasurer confirmed that in accordance with Policy 160 – Finance and Audit Committee, item 2.3, the Committee is required to make a recommendation to the Board on the annual authorization of trustee indemnity to be increased in accordance with the BC Consumer Price Index during the preliminary budget process. Trustee Baxter suggested that the recommendation to the Board of Education include reference to the Consumer Price Index.

Outcome

THAT: The Finance and Audit Committee recommends to the Board of Education:
THAT: The Board of Education set the Trustee Indemnity for the period effective July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019 in accordance with the January 2018 Consumer Price Index.

2. Review of Transportation Fees for the 2018/2019 Fiscal Year

The Assistant Secretary-Treasurer reviewed the memo of April 4, 2018. The Committee discussed the previous requirements by the Ministry of Education for the \$600,000 Student Transportation Fund imposed in August of 2016. A restriction on the funding was that the funding to be applied to eliminate fees for eligible families only (outside the traditional walk limits). This resulted in inequity among families with some paying the \$250/year and others riding at no cost. The Board of Education expressed to the Ministry of Education the inequity this requirement caused to families. The Ministry restrictions for the funding are now removed allowing the District an opportunity to return to the previous system that is more equitable and provides a benefit to everyone wishing to use the transportation system.

The Committee reviewed the analysis provided for the three rate options. The staff recommendation of \$150/year fee applied to all riders would allow the District to create a more equitable fee structure. This proposal would also cover the expected 2018/2019 transportation shortfall while also achieving a more equitable system for the District's bus riders.

The Committee recommended the base transportation fee be set at \$200/year, which together with the Ministry funding, would provide an anticipated surplus of approximately \$190,000 which would be considered for use towards additional bus routes.

The fee per rider would be reduced for additional riders in a family. The Committee discussed forwarding the recommendation on the transportation fee to the April 11th Public Board Meeting in order that the Board decision can become part of the budget process.

THAT: The Finance and Audit Committee recommends to the Board of Education: THAT: The Board of Education set the transportation fee to \$200/year for each bus rider for the period effective July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019.

current and additional budget request information. The Superintendent of Schools/CEO 2018/2019 Budget Recommendations report will be updated pursuant to discussions at the Committee level and brought forward as an action item to the April 18th Finance and Audit Meeting.
