Recognition/Presentations/Delegations

1. Exploring the Concept of a Family Hub (K-12)

Jon Rever, Director of Instruction (K-12), shared that the purpose of the presentation was to introduce the concept of a Family Hub at Pearson Road Elementary School, receive feedback from the committee, and determine the next steps.

Rob Zoppi, Principal, Pearson Road Elementary School, provided a brief presentation that included the challenges families are met with when accessing community services and highlighted the potential benefits of a Family Hub. Data collected from the Early Development Instrument (EDI) for the Kelowna area indicates that 29% of children are vulnerable in at least one of the following areas: poverty, transportation, and/or life circumstances (resiliency). Research shows that a Family Hub has the potential to promote family stability, decrease violence, lessen the need for crisis services, and increase school success. A Family Hub supports streamlining community services in one location for families in the community.

The presenters were encouraged to present at an upcoming Health Promoting Schools committee meeting in order to inform the committee's community members of the Family Hub concept.

Outcome

The Committee supported the concept of a Family Hub Project at Pearson Road Elementary School. This item will be added to the November 5, 2014 Education and Student Services Committee meeting.
