Dear Parents of Students in Lake Country Area Schools,

As you are aware, the elementary schools in the Lake Country area (Davidson Road, Peter Greer, and Oyama Traditional) have a combined enrolment that exceeds the capacity of the three facilities. As such, 2013/2014 will be the last school year that the elementary enrolment in Lake Country can be physically and functionally accommodated in the three elementary schools.

To address the enrolment pressures in the Lake Country area, a series of public presentation and consultation meetings were held over the past few years as part of the School District Long-Term Facility Plan. Parents also had the opportunity to provide feedback through the online THOUGHTstream process. In early spring of 2013, focus group meetings with representatives from each of the elementary schools in the Lake Country area provided further opportunities to discuss future school organization options.

At the June 19, 2013 Planning and Facilities Public Committee Meeting, the committee members reviewed all input and put forth the following recommendation to the Board of Education:

"THAT: The Board of Education approve the relocation of Grade 7 students from Oyama Traditional School, Peter Greer Elementary School and Davidson Road Elementary School to George Elliot Secondary School where an interim Grade 7-8 middle school program will be created, as of September 2014;

AND THAT: The Board of Education direct staff to work with the George Elliot Secondary School administration and the District of Lake Country to develop plans for a six classroom portable annex to house the Grade 7 students."

At the June 26, 2013 Public Board Meeting, the Board of Education approved the relocation of Grade 7 students from Lake Country elementary schools to George Elliot Secondary School in September 2014. Over the 2013/2014 school year, staff will work to develop, in consultation with the community, a transition plan to create an interim Grade 7-8 middle school within George Elliot Secondary School in order to alleviate enrolment pressures at the elementary level.
