## Weather Advisory School and Transportation Updates

## Kelowna, B.C.

The heavy snowfall overnight presented a number of challenges for both schools and school buses this morning. We continue to communicate with our utility providers for updates. Currently the following schools are experiencing power outages: Peachland Elementary and Oyama Traditional Schools. We anticipate the power being restored in Oyama within the next hour, so students are being kept at the school at this time. The power is not expected to be restored at Peachland Elementary until closer to noon today, so staff at the school are contacting parents and trying to make alternate arrangements for those students today. Families who can pick up their children in Peachland are welcome to do so at their convenience. Students who don't have an alternative will be kept at the school.

Our buses have been operating on their regular routes, however, delays were experienced this morning. All buses have now concluded their morning runs.

Schools will be operating to the best of their ability today, however, we recognize that there have been challenges with some students and staff being able to make their way to school this morning.
