You may choose to do this activity through the library, give the blanks to teachers to use in the classrooms, order them just for your intermediate (or primary) students, or even offer the bookmarks as an enrichment challenge. You may want to provide them to every student in your school or just certain) grade levels. Whatever you decide, **please order only what you will use for Harmony Day**, as the tag-board and labour involved will have a cost to our budget.
