# **Discussion/Action Items**

# 1. Central Okanagan Proposal for BC Integrated Youth Services Initiative

Shelagh Turner, Executive Director of the Canadian Mental Health Association (CMHA) Kelowna, and Mike Gawliuk, Director of Service Delivery and Program Innovation of the CMHA Kelowna, presented on a proposal they are preparing to participate in a 36-month province-wide initiative (BC-IYSI) to support youth and young adults aged 12-24 in the Central Okanagan. If successful, this initiative would provide easy access to integrated services including primary care, mental health, substance use, and social services for Central Okanagan children and families. The Canadian Mental Health Association Kelowna will prepare an Expression of Interest (EOI) submission by January 29, 2016. Up to three communities from each Health Authority that submit an EOI response will be selected to move to phase 2, which includes \$5,000 for convening, and creation of a full proposal.

The Education and Student Services Committee supported the concept of a BC Integrated Youth Services Initiative in the Central Okanagan. At this time, CMHA Kelowna is requesting that the Board of Education provide a Letter of Support for the concept of a BC Integrated Youth Services Initiative in the Central Okanagan.

Vianne Kintzinger, Director of Instruction (K-12), outlined the amendments on Forms 436.1, 436.2, 436.3, and 436.4, as well as shared the new Form 436.5. Significant changes were made to Forms 436.1 and 436.4, resulting in a rewrite of both forms. The amendments to the existing forms and addition of the new form were the result of consultation with the Interior Health Authority.

The Committee discussed the proposed rewrites to Forms 436.1 and 436.4, the amendments to Forms 436.2 and 436.3, the addition of new Form 436.5, and recommended a few amendments before forwarding to the Board of Education for approval.

All of our Secondary school websites include links to both documents. Throughout a student's grade 12 year, school staff review each grade 12 students' courses to ensure each students' timetable reflects all the required courses for graduation.

Terry-Lee Beaudry, Assistant Superintendent of Schools, provided an update on the upcoming Non-Instructional Day on February 9, 2016. The Joint Educational Change Committee (JECC) is responsible for planning the NID. The District's eReg went live on Wednesday, January 20, 2016, offering 58 sessions to teachers and administrators on the redesigned curriculum.

April Smith, First Vice-President, COTA, shared that a lot of work has been done by our Teacher Facilitators to plan the learning for the day. The Keynote speakers for the day will focus on the 'Why' around the redesigned curriculum and the implementation of Aboriginal content.

COPAC Sponsored Ministry Presentation – Redesigned Curriculum and the Graduation Program Shelley Courtney, President, COPAC, shared that the COPAC is sponsoring a Ministry Presentation on the Redesigned Curriculum and Graduation Program.
