## **Summary of School District's Return to School Plan**

On July 29, 2020 the Province of British Columbia announced that K-12 schools would be scheduled to begin the 2020/21 school year under Stage 2 of the Province's K-12 Education Restart Plan. The Plan for September has been developed based on the advice and recommendations from the Provincial Health Officer (PHO) to ensure health and safety measures are in place to protect students and school staff.

THAT: Regulation 405R – Student Placement (Regulations) be amended as follows:

## 2. Enrolment Priorities

- catchment area students who, in the previous year, were 'placed' by the district in a different school;
- siblings of catchment area students;
- <u>returning catchment area students that have transferred into the school or</u> program they previously attended from eSchoolBC;
- new catchment area students;
- siblings of non-catchment area students currently enrolled in the school;
- non-catchment area students who request to attend the school which is other than their catchment area school;
- non-district area students:
- international students.

AND THAT: For the 2020-21 school year, students with approved medical conditions and their siblings in the same household that attend the District's remote learning may resume in person instruction at their school at any point in the year;

For registration in the 2021-22 school year these students will be considered to have in the previous year, attended the school;

AND THAT: For the 2020-21 school year, students that enroll in the District's remote learning at their school shall retain their enrolment at their school if they resume in-person instruction at their school prior to November 13, 2020. After this date, students shall remain the remainder of the year in the District's remote learning program;

For registration in the 2021-22 school year, these students will be considered as returning catchment area students that have transferred into the school from eSchoolBC;

THAT FURTHER THAT: Transportation fees will not be prorated for families that hold their bus seat during the transitional period.
