## **COMMITTEE MEMBERS QUERIES/COMMENTS**

**Trustee Fraser** queried if there is a line item on the financial statements related to COVID-19 impacts.

The Assistant Secretary-Treasurer stated that as of June 30, 2020, the District had a net savings of \$1.3 million which was appropriated to the 2020-2021 Budget and is anticipated to cover expected lost revenues due to students enrolling in remote learning options. For the 2020-2021 school year, multiple accounts related to COVID-19 have been set up. The District has received both Provincial and Federal funding to cover additional costs associated with COVID-19.

In response to a comment by the COTA President, the Assistant Secretary-Treasurer also stated that the District has a shortfall of \$1.6 due to secondary students not enrolled in as many courses.

## 2020-2021 Budget Timeline and Budget Development Principles

The Assistant Secretary-Treasurer outlined the 2020-2021 Budget Timeline and Budget Development Principles. The Budget Timeline outlines the significant dates and deadlines pertaining to both the amendments of the current year's budget as well as the development of next year's budget. The Budget Development Principles were developed a number of years ago and serve as a guideline when making budget decisions.

## **Outcome**

The Committee recommended that the Board of Education approve the 2020-2021 Budget Timeline as presented at the November 18, 2020 Finance and Audit Committee Meeting.
