#### DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS

# École Dr. Knox Middle School – Golf Academy Fee Increase

Luke Campbell, Principal - École Dr. Knox Middle School, and Dave Roberts, Teacher - École Dr. Knox Middle School, presented the proposed fee increase for the Golf Academy at École Dr. Knox Middle School. Prior to the proposed 2024/2025 changes, the student fee for the Golf Academy at École Dr. Knox Middle School was approved at a rate of \$400 per student in 2013. The proposed fee increase to \$500 per student takes into consideration the increased bus transportation rates due to inflation, the added fuel expenses to separately transport the golf clubs to the golf course, and the increase in coaching session fees. The proposed fee increase, supported by the École Dr. Knox Middle School Parent Advisory Council, will ensure the Golf Academy is financially sustainable.

#### **Outcome:**

The Committee recommended that the Board of Education approve the proposed fee increase of \$100 (from \$400 to \$500) for the Golf Academy (École Dr. Knox Middle School), as attached to the Agenda, and as presented at the November 29, 2023 Education and Student Services Committee Meeting.

# <u>Proposal for Substantive Change – Outdoor Education Academy (École Glenrosa Middle School)</u>

Bobbi Hunter, Principal - École Glenrosa Middle School, Stephanie Read, Vice-Principal - École Glenrosa Middle School, and Liam Wallis, Teacher - École Glenrosa Middle School, presented a proposal for an Outdoor Education Academy at École Glenrosa Middle School (GMS). Students in the Outdoor Education Academy will have the opportunity to access outdoor activities and places they otherwise may not be able to experience. This would be accomplished through day field studies, overnight hiking trips, and guest speakers with expertise in fishing, outdoor safety and first aid skills, and back country hiking. Students will benefit physically, mentally, and socially as they engage in several different forms of physical activity with other students, and they will broaden their knowledge of how to use natural spaces responsibly as well as interact with wildlife respectfully. The long-term goal of the Outdoor Education Academy is for students to foster a love for the outdoors, which will hopefully turn into a life-long passion for outdoor activities, stewardship, and enjoyment. An Outdoor Education Academy at GMS would enable parents to know total associated costs up front for the semester's activities and would align GMS with the other West Kelowna school communities, which all have Outdoor Education Academies.

## **Outcome:**

The Committee recommended that the Board of Education approve the Proposal for Substantive Change – Outdoor Education Academy (École Glenrosa Middle School), as attached to the Agenda, and as presented at the November 29, 2023 Education and Student Services Committee Meeting.
