4010 – DISTRICT SUSPENSION REVIEW COMMITTEE

Introduction

The District Suspension Review Committee is an auxiliary committee of the Board of Education with the following membership:

- Superintendent of Schools/CEO (or designate) as Chair;
- one Trustee appointed on a rotating basis.

Policy

The District Suspension Review Committee shall meet pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Procedure - Discipline and Administrative Procedure – Discipline (Regulations) to:

- hear student suspensions in excess of ten days;
- develop and implement recommendations concerning the health, education and welfare of the suspended student.
