
LAKE COUNTRY ELEMENTARY DATA

PURPOSE AND MANDATE OF THE FOCUS GROUP

April 1, 2015 Board of Education Interchange

- Development of a Focus Group meeting consisting of representatives from the three elementary schools' PACs and George Elliot Secondary.

April 8, 2015 Public Board Meeting Motion 15P-048

THAT: The Board of Education cap Davidson Road Elementary at 485 students for September 2015.

Motion 15P-050

THAT: The Board of Education redirect the overflow to École Peter Greer Elementary School for the 2015/2016 school year.

GOALS FOR CATCHMENT AREA REVIEW

June 2014

As part of the Long-Term Facility Plan Catchment Area Review Workplan:

- Minimize disruptions to families created through capping and redirecting
- Make the most effective use of our existing facilities
- Create sustainable enrolment levels in each elementary school within Lake Country

During the last review process, staff emphasized the need to:

- Relieve the pressure on Davidson Road Elementary School for the long term.
- 2. Proactively address the anticipated growth in the Southwest quadrant.
- 3. Distribute the student population more evenly between the three Lake Country elementary schools.
