Presentation: Canadian Student Leadership Conference 2014 - Update

- Presenters: Derek Lea, Principal, George Elliot Secondary School Aidan Lea, Grade 11, Kelowna Secondary School (KSS)

A presentation was provided on the September 2014 Canadian Student Leadership Conference (CSLC) which will be hosted by the Central Okanagan School District. Over 1,000 students from across Canada are expected to attend the five-day conference. The event will include a conference carnival, a provincial march of students, workshops, community service at elementary schools, a tour of the University of British Columbia Okanagan Campus, a Trade Show, a Ted Ex Show and a tour of Kelowna. A recent talent show held for District students has resulted in over 30 acts to be performed by students at various venues throughout the conference. Central Okanagan School District leadership students are taking part in spirit leader training in preparation for the conference. The CSLC Committee is actively seeking families willing to offer accommodation to students attending the conference. Aidan Lea, KSS leadership student, provided comments on past Canadian Student Leadership Conferences.

Queried the status of construction for the Okanagan Mission Secondary School Addition and the new Mar Jok Elementary School.

The Secretary-Treasurer responded that construction of Mar Jok Elementary School is slightly ahead of schedule and the school is expected to open in September as planned. Work on the Okanagan Mission Secondary School Addition is slightly behind schedule, with completion of the academic wing expected to be late August. Finishing touches for other areas, e.g. the gym, may need to be completed in September.

<u>Draft Board Correspondence to the Minister of Education Regarding the Expectation that Districts Will Use Any Surplus Funds to Share the Cost of Capital Projects, and Expressing Concern Regarding Public Education Funding</u>

Discussion included concerns regarding shortfalls in funding, and additional municipal, provincial and federal cost pressures, e.g. employee benefit increases, and utility increases. Standardized funding for school districts was also discussed, which would allow districts to complete long range planning for future years. Opportunities should be explored for school districts and the Ministry to work together, possibly sharing resources, which could lead to savings for all districts.
