

# DISTRICT HEALTH PROMOTING SCHOOLS COMMITTEE Terms of Reference

#### 1. Committee Mandate

- a. The Central Okanagan Public Schools Health Promoting Schools Committee defines 'health' based on the WHO definition of health¹ and has the following mandate:
  - i. Assist in the development of a Comprehensive Health Promoting Schools Plan utilizing the key components addressed in Policy 423-Health Promoting Schools.
  - ii. Act as a resource for and receive input from school based committees.
  - iii. Review various District Health Promoting Schools related initiatives.
  - iv. Assist the Superintendent with general oversight, planning, evaluation of all aspects of the District and school health programs.
  - v. Provide recommendations to the Assistant Superintendent, Board of Education, Joint Health & Safety Committee and to Interior Health on further program planning.

## 2. Committee Composition and Length of Term

- a. In general, the Health Promoting Schools Committee shall be comprised of the following representatives:
  - i. District staff (1)
  - ii. Trustees (1) and Alternate (1)
  - iii. CUPE (1)
  - iv. COTA (4 Elementary, Middle, Secondary school & Sexual Health Team representation)
  - v. COPVPA (3 Elementary, Middle, and Secondary school representation)
  - vi. COPAC (3 Elementary, Middle, and Secondary school representation)
  - vii. Mental Health Community (ARC/Foundry/CMHA) (1)
  - viii. Indigenous Education (1)
  - ix. Associate Member/s (non-voting, two year term)
  - x. District Student Council (1)
- b. Student representatives from all secondary schools will be invited to participate/provide input when determined by committee need. For the purpose of the quorum, District Student Council representation will be included.
- c. Membership will be solicited and maintained by the executive of the representative association.

## d. Membership Term

i. To ensure continuity and vitality of the committee, in general, each member on the committee will be asked to serve a two-year term.

#### e. Sub-Committees

- i. The committee, as a whole, can approve the formation of sub-committees on an "adhoc" basis as needs arise.
- ii. Membership of sub-committees will be solicited at a meeting of the whole committee and should strive for equitable representation when possible.

# 3. Roles and Responsibilities of Committee Members

- a. Committee members are expected to fulfil the following roles and responsibilities as it relates to Health Promoting Schools initiatives in the Central Okanagan School District:
  - i. Represent a defined constituent group by:
    - Communicating, educating and providing feedback to the committee
    - Role-modeling Health Promoting Schools principles and practices
    - Providing leadership and guidance to constituent members.
  - ii. Support, participate and contribute to the business of the committee.
  - iii. Commitment to continuous growth and learning in regards to Health Promoting Schools research and practice.

# 4. Committee Operation

- a. Meetings
  - i. Meetings will be coordinated and facilitated by the committee chairperson(s).
  - ii. The committee will meet five times during the school year to conduct the business of the committee.
    - Additional meetings can be held to address emerging issues as agreed upon by the committee.
  - iii. Meeting dates will be developed and agreed upon by the committee in advance of the meeting date.
  - iv. Minutes of the regular committee meetings will be recorded and distributed to committee members.

## b. Decision Making

- i. In general, the committee will endorse a consensus model to make decisions with the majority to rule. Quorum = 50 % +1 (9 committee members)
- ii. Decisions made by the committee will be recorded in the committee meeting minutes.
- c. Terms of Reference Review
  - i. All changes to the Terms of Reference will be agreed upon by the committee.
