We are asking that you read this email thread in its entirety as a small insight of our request.

This is a very unfortunate circumstance for a student who wants to further their education with resources that are offered at a school only 10 minutes from our house. A child who wants to excel, to be challenged, and has proven to be an exceptional overall student is denied admission because of our address! We don't have the option of the Advanced Placement courses at MBSS, nor the choral program, Orchestra nor Rhythm and Blues, which makes this very frustrating. I know exceptions have been made for students of all degrees, and we wish to be heard in regard to this particular circumstance!

I don't believe an address should deter this request when we don't have the comparable AP courses on our side of the bridge. For a student who wants to be a Pediatric ER Psychologist and who also wants to further challenge themselves in Music Theory, I would hope they have the support to achieve their goals. Our child is being denied this opportunity, and our only option is to move within catchment! Not acceptable!

We understand that KSS is over capacity, but MBSS is also over capacity and does not offer the equivalent courses.

We moved to the Okanagan 3.5 years ago, and did not know that catchment and school capacities would be a deterrent for students who want to excel in their learning. These programs should be accessible to ALL students who choose to take this learning path no matter where they live!

We would like to speak to someone who can help in this situation.
