## **Committee Members Queries/Comments**

#### **Trustee Baxter:**

Advised that the Provincial Government's Select Standing Committee on Finance and Government Services released their "Report on the Budget 2014 Consultations" on November 14, 2013. The Report included discussion regarding education matters.

### **Outcome**

The Committee agreed that the Report would be added to the November 27, 2013 Public Board Meeting Agenda as an Information Item.

## **Discussion/Action Items**

# 1. 2014/2015 Budget Development Process

The Director of Finance provided a copy of the School District's 2013/2014 Preliminary Budget Proposal - Superintendent's Budget Recommendations. Committee members discussed the evolution of the budget development process and the current format as outlined in the handout. The process includes public meetings of the Finance and Legal Committee and the Board where partner group and public input is encouraged, as well as a public presentation at a COPAC Meeting early in the New Year. As well, reviews of each of the District's significant programs and services are completed on a three-year cycle and include a detailed budget for that program or service.

#### Outcome

Committee members agreed with the current budget development process and no changes were recommended to the existing format. The Director of Finance will incorporate the budget presentation made at the recent School Planning Council Orientation Sessions into the annual budget presentation at the COPAC Meeting which takes place early in the New Year.

## 2. School District No. 23 (Central Okanagan) 2014/2015 Budget Development Timeline

The Committee reviewed the budget development timeline which is similar to the previous year's timeline.

### **Outcome**

The Committee recommended that the Board of Education approve the School District No. 23 (Central Okanagan) 2014/2015 Budget Development Timeline.

3. Policy Review: Policy 205 - Administration of Finances; Policy 206 - Purchasing; Policy 207 - Investments; and Policy 208 - Confidential Disclosure: Reporting and Investigating Allegations of Financial Irregularity

## **Policy 205 - Administration of Finances**

Committee members reviewed the policy which, given technological advancements for direct deposit and electronic transfer of funds, is now redundant. Per audit requirements, the District has checks and balances in place which ensure that no single employee can create and process a cheque, direct deposit or electronic transfer from beginning to end.

### **Outcome**

The Committee recommended that the Board of Education approve the deletion of Policy 205 - Administration of Finances.

## Policy 206 - Purchasing

The Committee reviewed the current policy.

### **Outcome**

The Committee recommended that the Board of Education affirm Policy 206 - Purchasing with no recommended changes.

## **Policy 207 - Investments**

The Committee reviewed the amendments to the policy and made several further amendments as follows:

- 5. Bond positions will be constrained by the following:
  - i. Federal Bonds 25% 0% minimum range 100% maximum range
- 7. All Bonds will have 'A' 'BBB' or better credit rating.
- 8. A comprehensive portfolio review including <u>a</u> portfolio evaluation <del>and a review of this Policy</del> will be performed annually <del>to ensure it continues to meet the Board's requirements</del>.

### **Outcome**

The Committee recommended that the Board of Education approve amended Policy 207 - Investments.

Policy 208 - Confidential Disclosure: Reporting and Investigating Allegations of Financial Irregularity The Committee reviewed the amendments to the policy, which are housekeeping in nature.

#### Outcome

The Committee recommended that the Board of Education approve amended Policy 208 - Confidential Disclosure: Reporting and Investigating Allegations of Financial Irregularity.

## 4. Revenue and Expense Summary at October 31, 2013

The Director of Finance provided a brief overview of the Revenue and Expense Summary at October 31, 2013. Current enrolment is 109 students over projection with 104 additional identified special needs students. Ministry funding will be increased by approximately \$2.4 million to accommodate the increased enrolment numbers, with \$1.7 million allocated to special education for the additional identified students. Committee members discussed the information provided.

### **Outcome**

The Committee received the Revenue and Expense Summary at October 31, 2013, and recommended that the Revenue and Expense Summary at October 31, 2013 be forwarded to the Board of Education as an Information Item.
