

Background

- High priority in School Replacement Program Board has been advocating for replacement for more than seven years
- Aging buildings and functionality of multiple buildings not suitable for elementary students
- Glenmore Elementary is overcapacity with 660 students in a building designed for 475 - uses six portables
- Lacks accessibility, security, functionality, support space



Project Plan Build a new elementary school on the current site.

Opportunities



Modern learning spaces in a single building conducive to elementary learning, student safety, and learning support spaces

Increased capacity for a rapidly growing neighbourhood, reduction of portable use in the area

Most cost-effective option

Allows for options such as neighbourhood learning centre and community partnerships

Keeps students learning close to home

Provides enough space for the current dual track (English and French Immersion) programs to continue and grow
