**June 10 Agenda for Public Board Meeting – Gordon Drive Rezoning and OCP Amendment**

Thank you for your correspondence regarding the proposed rezoning and Official Community Plan amendment for 4482 and 4498 Gordon Drive.

The Board appreciates you sharing your concerns about the potential traffic impacts and student safety considerations associated with the proposed development, particularly given its proximity to nearby schools and childcare facilities.

The School District works collaboratively with the City of Kelowna on matters related to student safety and transportation. District staff regularly communicate with City staff regarding school-area traffic conditions, active transportation routes, and safety considerations, and participate in established channels for sharing information and raising concerns.

As this matter is part of the City of Kelowna's planning and rezoning process, the Board of Education does not have a direct role in the review or decision-making process. As such, your request to present at the June 10, 2026 Board Meeting is respectfully declined. We encourage you to continue engaging through the City's established consultation and planning processes and trust the City will consider the potential traffic and safety impacts as part of its review, including the concerns raised by nearby residents and school communities.
