

### SCHOOL OPENING/ ENROLMENT TRENDS



- Increase of 466 students from original projection
- Increase of 666 students over last year's September 30, 2022 numbers
- Current student headcount is 25,184





# INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION/ THE WELCOME CENTRE



- There are 412 students confirmed to come to the Central Okanagan during the 2023/2024 school year. To date there are 438 fee paying students who have arrived and another 105 coming in the second half of the school year.
- The students attending in the International Program for the 2023/2024 school year represent **29** countries and jurisdictions.





# INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION/ THE WELCOME CENTRE



- The Welcome Centre staff have welcomed 331 students and their families from 44 countries to the Central Okanagan.
- There are currently 2,108 newly immigrated children attending Central Okanagan Public Schools - all of whom are supported through the Welcome Centre and the Settlement Workers in Schools (SWIS) Program.
- The large numbers of newly arrived students and their families continue to have a positive impact creating a much more culturally diverse and globally aware local community. Our students, teachers and schools are enriched through the exchange of ideas and infusion of culture from around the world.





### **HUMAN RESOURCES RECRUITMENT**

- 525 support staff postings, which included 208 CEA postings were processed in 2022/2023.
- 226 teacher postings were processed during the Spring staffing period.
- This summer approximately 230 full-time temporary contracts were awarded to teachers.
- Since September 2022, approximately **185** new teachers were hired into temporary contracts or placed on our Teachers Teaching on Call (TTOC) list.
- We now employ close to 4,183 employees (FTE) or 4,443 headcount.
- Over the months of September and October, recruitment will continue for CEAs, bus drivers and other Operations Department staff.



#### RECRUITING TEACHERS



- In addition to other universities within and outside of our province, our partnership with the Teacher Education Program at the University of British Columbia-Okanagan (UBC-O) continues to provide our District with high quality beginning teachers throughout K-12. We expect a graduating class of approximately 126 elementary, middle and secondary teachers in December 2023.
- We are currently hosting a large majority of the teacher candidates from UBC-O, and anticipate others from the University of Victoria, University of Calgary, and University of British Columbia – Vancouver.





#### FINANCIAL



- The external auditors have concluded their year-end review of the District's financial reports. The fiscal and accounting and control processes were once again found to be comprehensive and appropriate.
- The 2023/2024 annual budget is \$347,647,368.





#### **FACILITY UPDATES**



- There were a substantial number of projects completed in addition to the normal custodial clean-up that took place in every school in the District.
- Routine maintenance of facilities, grounds and custodial summer cleaning was also carried out.







# RCMP BACK TO SCHOOL SPEED ZONE CAMPAIGN



- In partnership with partner agencies such as BC Highway Patrol, the Kelowna RCMP conducted a proactive initiative during the first of week of school to raise awareness about school speed zone safety.
- 88 warnings were issued to drivers, all of which were related to speeding.
