This is an excellent opportunity! Anyone can benefit from learning Mental Health First Aid: parents, teachers, counsellors, coaches, program leaders, grandparents, aunts, uncles, and the list goes on ...

- In Canada, **one** person in **three** will experience a mental health problem in their lifetime.
- One in five will experience some problem with their mental health in the course of a year.
- Half of all mental disorders begin by age 14, and 75% begin by age 24.

Why should you take the course? Get involved and join over 38,500 mental health first aiders across Canada. Mental Health First Aid teaches participants how to help someone who is showing signs of a mental health problem or experiencing a mental health crisis. This is basic first aid for mental health and information that can be used in your daily life. This course provides you with an understanding of when you need to worry about what you are observing. The more people who are able to provide a quick, caring

and supportive response for a youth who is struggling, then the more youth who may receive the support they need for a mental health problem or disorder.
