Recognition/Presentations/Delegations

1. Revised Early Learning Profile

Rhonda Ovelson, Assistant Superintendent, Donna Kozak, Early Learning Consultant, Nicole Crane, Early Learning Team Teacher, and Lisa Wilson, Early Learning Team Teacher, presented an overview of the revised Early Learning Profile. The recent revisions were made to better align the Early Learning Profile with the redesigned curriculum and our District Assessment Policy. The purpose of the Early Learning Profile is to understand where each child is in terms of literacy skills to help teachers determine their instructional next steps to support each early learner's literacy development.

Discussion/Action Item

1. Amendments to Policy 540 – Proposals for Substantive Change (Distinct Schools, Unique Programs and Specialty Academies)

Terry-Lee Beaudry, Deputy Superintendent of Schools, advised revisions to Board Policy 540 – Proposals for Substantive Change (Distinct Schools, Unique Programs and Specialty Academies) are recommended.

Outcome

The Committee recommended that Policy 540 – Proposals for Substantive Change (Distinct Schools, Unique Programs and Specialty Academies) be referred to the Coordinating Committee for placement on a future Board Policy Committee for further review and revision.

Discussion/Information Items

1. Instructional Leadership Team Program Review – Level 1

Jamie Robinson, District Principal for Leadership in Learning & Innovation, reviewed the overarching themes and recommendations from the recent level one Instructional Leadership Team Program Review. The report yielded two kinds of recommendations - operational (District staff to respond) and governance (Board of Education to respond/decide). The Instructional Leadership Team's response to the operational recommendations included:

- Explore opportunities to align with existing school inquiry processes to provide a greater number of educator' access to responsive, context sensitive professional learning.
- The ILT Program continue to focus on enhancing professional learning to support the implementation of the redesigned curriculum and the new graduation program 'in situ' (in schools and classrooms).
- Explore opportunities to connect educators with innovative practices across our District and province.
- Consider differentiated support for schools and teams and a transparent method of assignment of the ILT staff and explore various ways to communicate opportunities to all levels of the system.
- The ILT Program, along with other support services, continue to support the development of the collaborative Learning Services model.

Outcome

The Committee recommended that the three governance recommendations outlined in the 2017 Instructional Leadership Team Program Review be referred to a future General Affairs Incamera Meeting.

Terry-Lee Beaudry, Deputy Superintendent of Schools, and Jamie Robinson, District Principal for Leadership in Learning & Innovation, presented the draft Interim Guidelines for Communicating Student Learning (K-9), outlining the criteria to follow if schools wish to explore an alternate form of reporting/communicating student learning. These guidelines ensure an extensive parental consultation process. The shift in communicating student learning is to align with the redesigned curriculum to ensure quality communication of student learning to parents.
